Saturday, September 23, 2017

How to Get There

Kalispell, MT is located in Northwest Montana at the intersection of US Hwy 2 and US Hwy 93. The Lonesome Dove Guest Ranch is at 1805 Haywire Gulch, Kalispell, MT 59901. From Kalispell go west on US Hwy 2 about 7 miles and turn left on Smith Lake Road. Continue 1\3 mile and turn right on Smith Lake Road. Go about 100 yards and turn left on Haywire Gulch. Go about 1\2 mile and turn left at the Lonesome Dove Guest Ranch sign and continue to the end of the road.
